PURPOSE:

Under certain conditions, the body of the stall warning horn may contact the hand brake support channel assembly, creating an electrical short circuit, which will trip the circuit breaker and render the stall warning alarm inoperable.

This Service Letter provides troubleshooting information to identify the condition described. For aircraft affected, this Service Letter also announces a kit, which, when installed will provide additional clearance between the stall warning horn and adjacent airframe structure.

INSTRUCTIONS:

For aircraft operators that experience the stall warning circuit breaker tripping unexpectedly, a likely cause of this condition may be that the horn assembly is making intermittent contact with the hand brake support channel assembly. Proceed as follows to verify this condition:

- 1. Remove electrical power from the aircraft.




Figure 1 STALL WARNING HORN INSTALLATION (Typical)

- 2. Locate the stall warning horn assembly, which is mounted on the hand brake support channel assembly, midway between the firewall and the instrument panel as shown in Figure 1.
- 3. The Bracket 35203-002 is made from phenolic, and is somewhat flexible. Apply gentle hand pressure on the horn assembly, in the direction to allow the horn assembly to contact the flange of the hand brake support channel assembly.
- 4. Examine the area of contact. There is a black plastic insulating strip mounted on the flange of the hand brake support channel assembly. If the insulating strip does not prevent contact between the horn assembly and the hand brake support channel assembly, order and install "STALL HORN BRACKET REPLACEMENT KIT", Piper part number 88472-002.
- 5. Make a logbook entry indicating compliance with this Service Letter.
